Warren E. Buffett first took control of Berkshire Hathaway Inc., a small textile company, in April of 1965. A share changed hands for around \$18 at the time. Fifty letters to shareholders later, the same share traded for \$226,000, compounding investor capital at just under 21% per year-a multiplier of 12,556 times.

To the Stockholders of Berkshire Hathaway Inc.: Operating earnings in 1977 of \$21,904,000, or \$22.54 per share, were moderately better than anticipated a year ago. Of these earnings, \$1.43 per share resulted from substantial realized capital gains by Blue Chip Stamps which, to the extent of our proportional interest in that company, are included in our operating earnings figure.
