Conflict of Laws Defined. Conflict of laws signifies the difference between the laws of two or more jurisdictions that are applicable to a dispute in question. The results of the case depend upon the selection of the law to resolve the dispute. The conflict can be between federal and state laws,

among the state laws themselves, or between the laws of different countries.
