Document Based Assessment for Global History

What is a Document-Based Question, or DBQ? A document-based question is a writing task in which a student analyzes significant evidence— documents and other data—to reach an informed position, then presents that information in a persuasive, logical, and accurate essay. A document-based question (BDQ) is a means of assessment for learning. Students are tasked with analyzing documents regarding the social, economic, and political impact of globalization. The documents included are written passages, charts, political cartoons and images.
