Choose one phrasing style for the headings, and write them all the same way (in parallel structure). Use a separate numbered entry for each step. Don't explain things your training population already knows. Don't insult, bore, and turn off your audience by explaining things they already know. For example, if your goal is to train them how to make a common

household item, don't start by explaining what the item is. It's a toaster—they know what a toaster is.
