Sonos not working? How to fix the most common Sonos problems

You should check if the Wi-Fi and the speaker are on the same network. This is mostly the case if your speaker isn't connecting to the Wi-Fi network. Next, you should check network strength and speed. If Sonos speaker cannot communicate fast enough, then it'll result in timeouts and break the connection.

Try these steps first: 1. Reboot your router. Reboot your router by unplugging the power cable for 10 seconds and plugging it back in. 2. Reboot your Sonos players. Starting with any Sonos products that are wired to your router with an Ethernet cable, unplug the power for 5 seconds and then plug them back in. 3.

The fix for this error depends on how many Sonos products you have in your system. If you own a single Sonos product: Retry the update at least one more time. If the update still doesn't work, connect the Sonos product to your router using an Ethernet cable and try the update one more time.

Launch the Sonos Controller app from your Home screen. Tap on the Menu button. Tap on Settings in the menu. Tap on Add a Player or SUB button. Tap Next on the Connect To Power screen. Make sure your Sonos is plugged in before you continue! Tap Next on the bottom right of the screen, after you have seen the green light flashing on your Sonos speaker. The indicator or the mute/play/pause button may be flashing.

To verify seating of the adapter, place the Sonos One control panel down and press down on the adapter so that the plug fits snugly into the unit receptacle. Once verified the power adapter is plugged in, attempt to turn the unit On.
